SUNSUPER ANNOUNCES NEW BOARD APPOINTMENTS

Sunsuper chief executive officer Scott Hartley welcomed both new directors to the board and said their passion and experience in championing the interests and entitlements of Australian workers, particularly in relation to their superannuation, was unquestionable.

"Ms McLennan and Mr Clifford's acceptance of the directorships is a boost for the Fund and their appointments will complement the diverse and significant pool of talent already sitting on the Sunsuper board," Mr Hartley said.
