Sunsuper Dreams for a Better World offers \$150,000 in community grants

The new format will have four rounds a year, each with a different theme or category. The judges will select three finalists each quarter, who will each receive a \$5,000 grant. The public will then vote to determine the quarterly winner, and the finalist with the most public votes will receive another \$5,000 grant for their cause.

The quarterly winners will then be judged for additional grants of up to \$25,000, to be announced at the Sunsuper Dreams for a Better World Grand Final Awards Night.

Sunsuper's Customer Experience and Insights Executive General Manager, Teifi Whatley said Sunsuper Dreams for a Better World was all about helping people who wanted to do something positive in the community.

"Since the program's inception in 2011, Sunsuper Dreams for a Better World has awarded more than 57 grants to some amazing causes, including animal shelters, local sporting clubs, medical research projects and a children's hospital. But now we want to do more and help more of these inspiring projects.

"So whether your dream is to help your children's sporting club, a local hospital, a grassroots community group in your town, your favourite national charity or a not-for-profit organisation that's close to your heart, enter it online for the chance to win a grant for your cause."

The categories for each round are:

- Round one (Jan - Mar): Open category (entries close 31 January 2015)
- Round two (Apr – June): Health & people (entries close 30 April 2015)
- Round three (July – Sep): Sport & community (entries close 31 July 2015)
- Round four (Oct – Dec): Environment & animals (entries close 31 October 2015)
