

Sunsuper pledges support for Uluru Statement

Sunsuper, along with 21 other financial institutions, yesterday pledged its support for the Uluru Statement from the Heart and its call for the establishment of a First Nations voice in the constitution.

The signing coincided with the second anniversary of the Statement's creation by over 250 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander leaders at the foot of Uluru.

Sunsuper's Chair, Andrew Fraser, signed the pledge on the Fund's behalf.

"We believe supporting the Statement and rightfully acknowledging the first sovereign Nations of Australia is an important step in our country's journey towards reconciliation," said Mr Fraser.

"At Sunsuper, we're implementing a range of other internal initiatives to ensure that, as an organisation, we're honouring and respecting Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, many of whom are our members."

Sunsuper has also signed up to the First Nations Foundation's 2019 Big Super Day Out which provides free superannuation help and support to First Nations people.
