

“SUNSUPER NIGHT SKY PROMOTION”
TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Information on how to enter and the prizes form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
2. Entry is only open to Australian residents who are Sunsuper members.
3. Entrants must be 18 years old or over.
